To support students in making the decision about whether they would like to attend a Higher Education Institution, embark on a school leaver scheme or Higher Apprenticeship at some point after Year 13, we have arranged for students to attend the UCAS Convention at the ExCel Centre East London on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> April at 12.30pm.

This convention brings together exhibitors from all the universities in the UK and other higher education institutions in the UK as well as the EU, America and Canada. Companies that offer school leaver schemes are also present and seminars are offered in choosing courses, finance and student house experience.

Students will need to make their own way to the venue and meet outside the Excel centre at 12.15pm. If you daughter/son does not wish to make their own way there they can meet at East Croydon train station at 10.50am and travel with staff. The event will finish at 2.30pm and students will be able to make their own way back home. Again, if you would prefer your daughter/son to travel back with staff then please tick the box on the reply slip. Students will need to take a packed lunch or enough cash to buy food.
