To support students in making the decision about whether they would like to attend a Higher Education Institution, embark on a school leaver scheme or Higher Apprenticeship at some point after Year 13, we have arranged for students to attend the UCAS Convention at the ExCel Centre East London on Tuesday 28 March from 1.30pm.

This convention brings together exhibitors from all the universities in the UK and other higher education institutions in the UK as well as the EU, America and Canada. Companies that offer school leaver schemes are also present and seminars are offered in choosing courses, finance and student house experience.

Students will leave school at 11.15 and catch the bus to East Croydon Station to meet staff at East Croydon station at 11.45am. We will travel together to London Bridge and then take the tube to Canning Town and the DLR to Royal Victoria DLR station. The event will finish by 3pm and students will travel back with staff to East Croydon Station, from where they will be dismissed, unless you give permission for them to be dismissed from the ExCel Centre.
