

INFORMATION ON SIXTH FORM OFFERS

We want all our sixth form students to do well and to be enrolled on the appropriate courses for their ability. The decision on course choice is arrived at by ascertaining the average score of the eight best GCSE grades. If the candidate has taken less than 8 GCSEs in total, then the average is arrived at by dividing the appropriate number which have been taken. The following information can be used as a guide, however firm offers will only be made at enrolment

GCSE results	offer
5 x A*- B grades (Inc. E&M) English and Maths (Grade 5 or above)	3x A Levels or BTEC Extended Diploma + 1 A Level
5 x A*-C <i>Plus subject requirements for A level choice</i>	BTEC Extended Diploma

- All students will need a minimum grade of a 'B' or a '6' at GCSE in the subjects chosen for A Level
- All A Level courses, with the exception of Maths, (which is a legacy A Level), will only be offered as a two year A Level course
- If the pupil is on target for less than 5x A*-C they need to know that we do not offer level 2 courses of study and they should apply elsewhere
- A few students will be entered for AS exams in Year 12 as a stand-alone qualification in Maths only
- Students need a minimum of a '4' at GCSE in English and Maths
