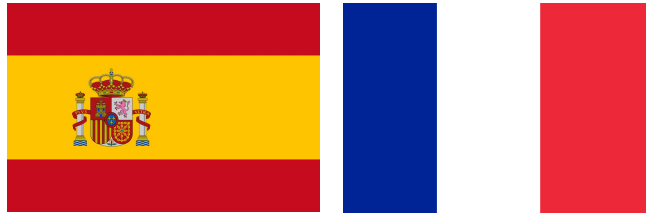

MODERN FOREIGN LANGUAGE DEPARTMENT

Modern Foreign Language at Shirley High School currently comprises of five full time specialist teachers, who teach throughout the school from Year 7 to Year 11; who are experienced and work as a well-integrated team. The department delivers French at Key Stage 3 and French and Spanish at Key Stage 4.

FRENCH AT KS3

There is a well established course for Years 7 and 8, developed in line with the national curriculum. Years 7 and 8 have three one hour lessons per fortnight.

FRENCH AND SPANISH AT KS4

At Year 9 the students opt to study French or Spanish and have five one hour lessons per fortnight. There are currently two hundred and sixty four students who have opted to study French at GCSE level and one hundred and twelve students studying Spanish making them very popular options.

FACILITIES

The department is located in one of the main school blocks. There are five classrooms; each with an interactive whiteboard and storage space.
